



Exercise 1: I can write in capital letters



Description

"**I can write in capital letters**" is an exercise dedicated to teaching handwriting in upper case capital letters using predefined words. Its objective is to adapt to the child's progression with automatic correction pathways if they are having difficulties.



Exercise Advantages

- Words are selected by the teacher
- Designed to teach every step of handwriting: word, individual strokes that make up a letter, individual displays for left and right handed children
- Interactive writing models that replay in real time
- Personalized writing models selected by the teacher
- Stroke analysis for each student (form, order, direction, precision, etc.) depending on the model selected by the teacher
- Automatic correction pathways for each student to perfect and correct difficulties perceived

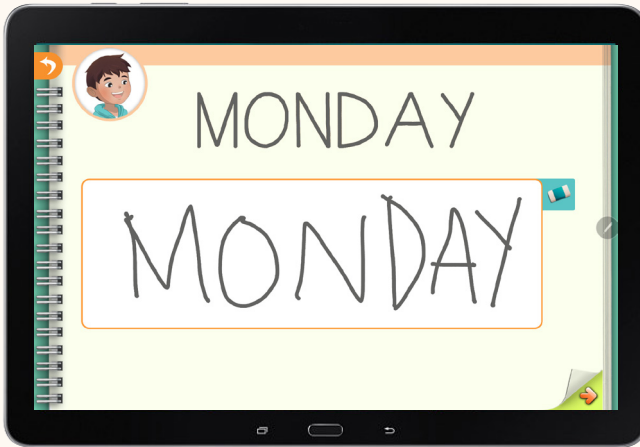




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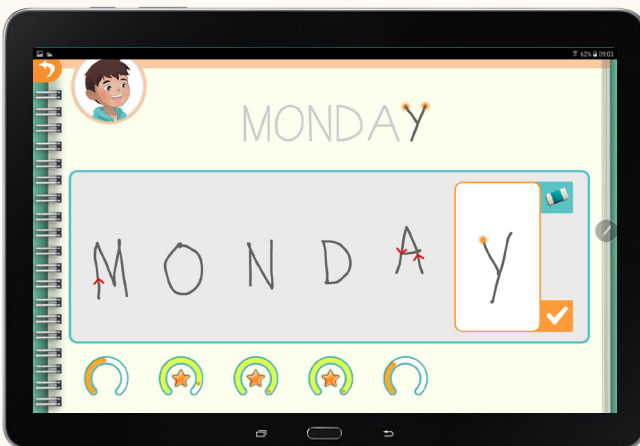
The child's first attempt

- No analysis



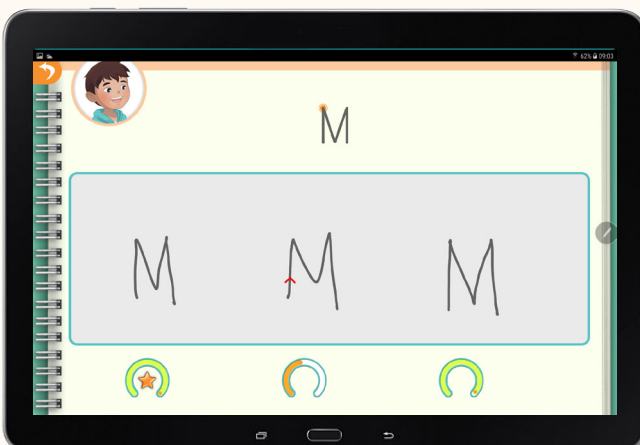
Learn the letter's strokes



- Write the word letter by letter
- Instruction: interactive model
- Visual feedback on stroke direction errors (red arrows)
- Stroke analysis



Automatic revision and correction



- Rewrite the letters where there were difficulties
- Instruction: interactive model
