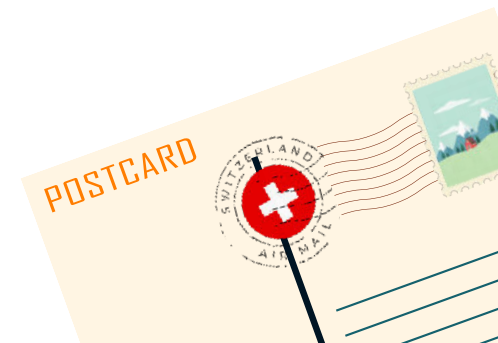


Kalicat loses his teddy

the lovely views.





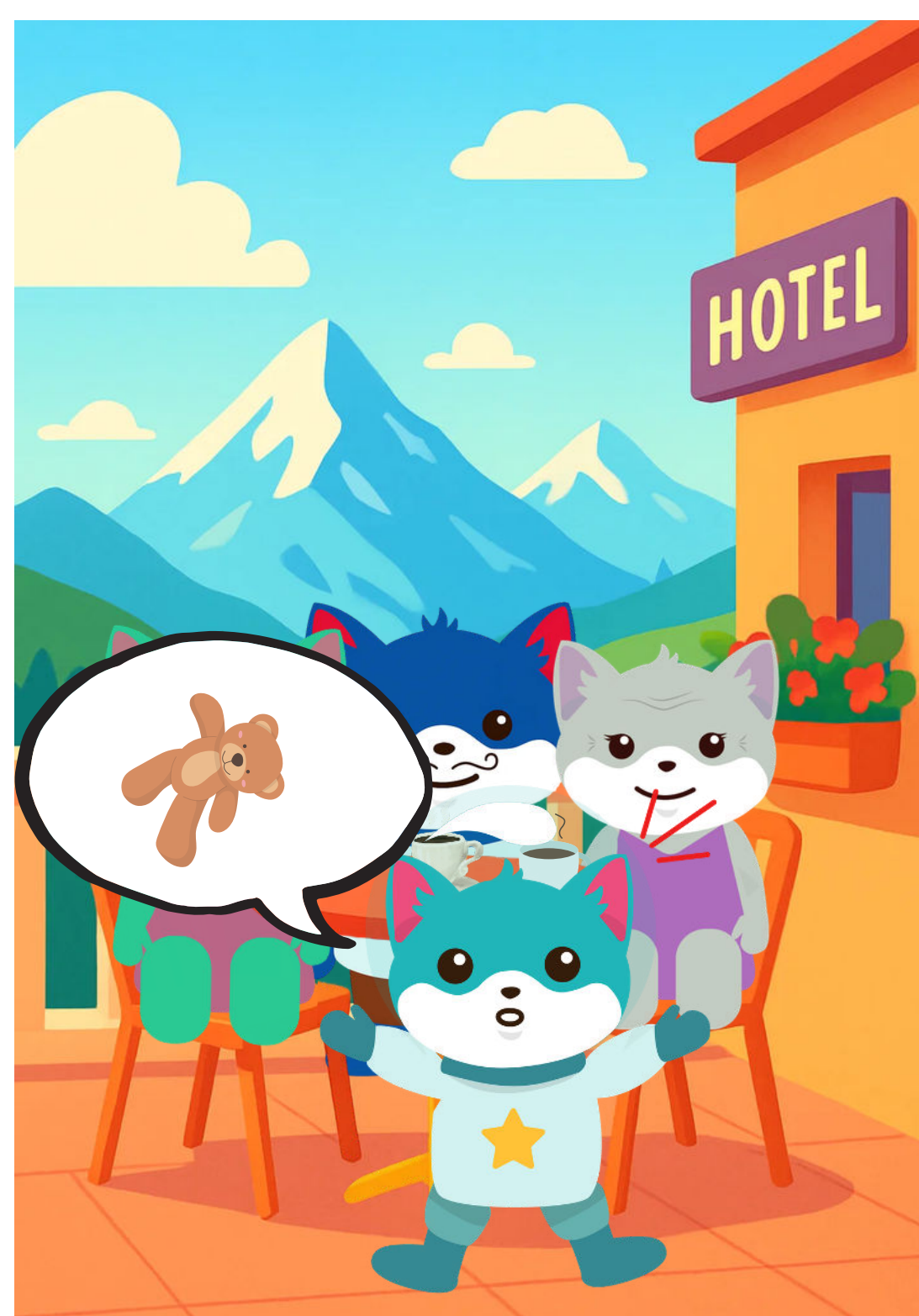
By mistake he goes

there can’t find Teddy.





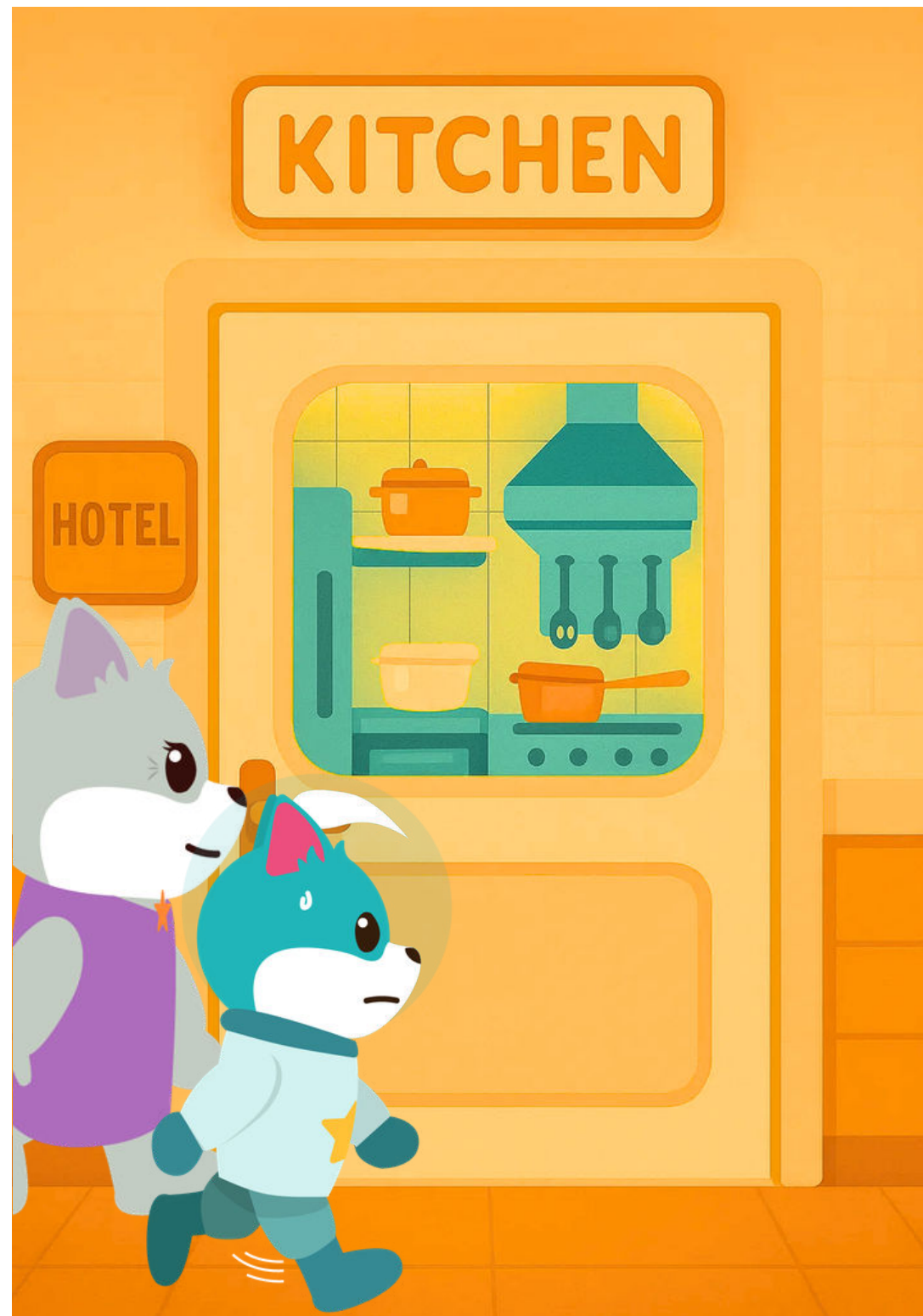
“Where else did you go Kalicat?” asks Gran.
